#### Note to the Financial Information

#### March 31, 2022

#### 1. Basis of accounting

The basis of accounting applied in the preparation of the statement of financial position of BC Hepatitis Network Society as at March 31, 2022, and the statement of operations and changes in net assets for the year then ended, is the historical cost basis and reflects cash transactions with the addition of the following:
